Tingrith Update

There has been plenty of work carried out on the Tingrith Complex recently and is continuing. Some of the Swim Platforms are in the process of being up-graded.

Much of the undergrowth and debris has been removed from Manor Lake area and Drainage Work is underway around some of waterlogged platforms. The Bridge over the culvert has also been repaired.

The Lilies have been comprehensively thinned and relocated in some areas.

A Portaloo is being installed ready for the start of the new season with keys being available from bailiffs, for a small charge. You will need to bring your own paper.

The Mere's roadside bank has been heavily seeded with perennial flowers and two benches installed.

The water level at Woodlands Lake has been high & has been pumped to take the water off the top of the platforms.

Copious amounts of anglers rubbish has been removed from the complex, including fishing line, so please take more care & take your rubbish home.
